“Vascular ageing: physiological and technical aspects”



The first VascAgeNet Training School took place in Split, Croatia from September 6th-8th 2021.

25 trainees from 16 Countries attended the theoretical and hands-on sessions.

The training school covered a broad range of topics deemed fundamental for early career researchers in the field of vascular ageing.

The programme included:

- Theoretical lessons on arterial physiology.
- Hands-on sessions on devices for vascular ageing assessment.
- A workshop on mathematical modelling.
- A moderated round-table with representatives of companies, researchers and clinicians discussing the way forward for effective translation from bench to bedside.
